Trams No. 2, 5, and 6 (Poříčí station) stop directly close to the faculty buildings.

In all public transport vehicles, you can pay with your card; just attach it to the yellow terminal located at each car door. The maximum amount you will be charged is 90CZK/day, which is 3.5 EUR, even if you change several times and use the transport frequently. However, be sure to bring your card with you every time you board the bus/ tram.
